




Cinderella - Rosalie Upton Jones

show!








**Buttons - Cye Gates** No sunny comments from me this year. This is for Sarah Jane X

After a long and distinguished stage career, Barbara's loved being directed by Nick almost as much as he's enjoyed trying to direct her!




The Prime Minister - Mike Heseldin\*

His role as Herald is a Triumph! (Motoring joke!)




Toby The Footman - Lynne Grimes\* Lynne's third panto with the Worthy Players. Evidently she prefers quantity over quality -


