This year Wendy and I thought it would be a change to do a Christmas play instead of the usual pantomime. A Christmas Carol was the obvious choice and, as normal, we leapt in with both feet and volunteered to produce it. This was before we discovered that most of the available scripts were a bit lacking in their interpretation of Dickens' tale. So we decided to put together our own version of his tale, using all the resources at our disposal.

This involved using the facilities at the Hospital Radio, and our thanks to Richard Aldous for making the arrangements, to make our recordings for the ethereal chorus. Miriam Edmonds looked after our music and recorded that, so we could add songs to the whole ensemble.

Again the Worthy Players set builders rose to the challenge when I came up with the set you see before you. This was necessary, as we have so many quick scene changes, that it would be impossible to do it by conventional means. Michael Edwards was responsible for the construction of the props and painting the scenery. Costumes were in the able hands of Gill Walker and Shirley Lovell who worked with Phoenix Theatre to supply the many changes that were required.
