

Clare is delighted to be back on stage again, in her now familiar role of the tart for one play, and the more unusual role of desert island survivor for the second.




Andrea Stubbins - Lady Cynthia

Mike Heseldin - Major Magnus and Miller


Mike has been a member of the Worthy Players since 1994 but it's 2 years since he last graced the stage. He's now very happy - nay, overjoyed - to be back!
